Fraser Fir	Uniform pyramid shape. Dark blue green soft short needles w/silverish underside, excellent needle retention. Open branches so ornaments can hang in the middle of the tree. Capable of lasting from Thanksgiving to New Years. Very popular tree.	Sturdy	Fragrant	Very sweet fragrance, yet still very traditional.	Best
Balsam Fir	Slightly tapered shape. Dark green soft short needles, and very good needle retention. Very fragrant. Room between branches for hanging ornaments. Will stay fresh the entire month of December. Long time favorite of many.	Sturdy	Most Fragrant	Traditional Christmas scent. The smell most people associate with Christmas.	Very Good
Canaan Fir	Beautiful uniform pyramid shape like the Fraser. Dark green soft short needles with silver accent underneath and excellent needle retention. Fragrance of a Balsam. Good spacing between branches for ornaments. Capable of lasting from Thanksgiving to New Years.	Sturdy	Most Fragrant	Traditional Christmas scent very similar to a Balsam Fir fragrance. The smell most people associate with Christmas.	Best
Concolor Fir	Non-traditional appearance, but a very pretty tree. Blue/green soft long needles and very good needle retention. Citrus fragrance. Will stay fresh the entire month of December.	Strong	Very Fragrant	Pine and citrus fragrance.	Very Good
Blue Spruce	Very full and beautiful shape. Color ranges from deep green to a bluish hew. Needles are sharp to touch. Dries out faster than a Fir tree. Good for about 3 weeks.	Strongest	Limited Fragrance	Pine fragrance	Fair
